She is a National Certified Trainer for Time to Teach, an instructional designer, and an entertainment industry coach. Adria was an award-winning opera singer and actor: her credits include her world-renowned Carmen in Bizet's opera to Family Guy. Adria won a Carbonell Award for Best Actress in a Musical (Aldonza in Man of La Mancha) and was voted Woman of the Year at the Spoleto Festival in Italy. For our troops in Desert Storm, from Shanghai to the Pacific Rim, and from Cairo to Canada, Adria has performed throughout the world.
